- Attend PEI Soccer meetings, coaching courses and other soccer events

• Communicate and plan with the team manager to make the necessary administrative decisions pertaining to the operation of the team

• Responsible for looking after equipment; example balls, cones, pinnies and uniforms

• Provide an enjoyable and safe sporting experience while conducting sportsmanship, and fair play
